FAQ

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What is Maths Circle?

Maths Circle is a weekly gathering aimed at fostering love for mathematics among students through interactive and engaging sessions.

When are the sessions held?

Sessions will be held every Saturday from 5:00 pm to 6:30 pm. However, the sessions may be extended in case of any guest lecture is scheduled.

Where will the sessions be conducted?

DPS Pre Primary Campus, S-703, Plot No. 44 & 46, Madhumangal Nagar, Near Arihant Nursing Home, Close to Nirmala Convent High School, Gangapur Road, Nashik – 422013

Who can join the Math Circle?

Math Circle is open to students from grades 6 to 8 who demonstrate a keen interest and aptitude in mathematics. Participation is determined through a selection test.

How can I apply for the selection test?

Interested students can apply for the selection test by filling out an online application form available on the website. [Click here to Apply.](#)

What does the selection test entail?

The selection test is designed to assess students' problem-solving abilities, and a solid understanding of standard middle school course work is sufficient. No specialized knowledge beyond the NCERT curriculum is required. It will entail 10-12 objective questions. There will be no need for calculators and there will be no negative marking.





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Is the selection test online or offline?

Selection test will be offline on November 1, 2025, and time will be communicated closer to the test.

Where will the selection test be conducted?

Can parents attend the sessions?

The problem sessions are primarily designed for students. However, parents are invited to participate in Guest Lectures.

Is there any program cost?

The cost of the program per student is borne by DPS Nashik. If you have the means to pay, you can make a monthly payment of your choice up to ₹1,100 to DPS Nashik.

Are there any homework or assignments given?

Participants may be given optional assignments or problems to work on at home to reinforce concepts learned during the sessions.

What if a participant misses a session?

If a participant misses a session, they can catch up by reviewing the materials provided and reaching out to the instructors for any assistance needed.
