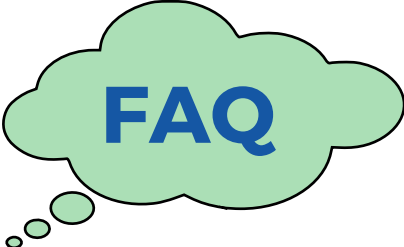

What is Maths Circle?

Maths Circle is a weekly gathering organized by Raising A Mathematician Foundation, aimed at fostering love for mathematics among students through interactive and engaging sessions.

When are the sessions held?

Sessions will be held every Sunday, which includes guest lectures, if scheduled.

Where will the sessions be conducted?

Selected students will be invited to join RAM Maths Circle Chennai as per your location preference.

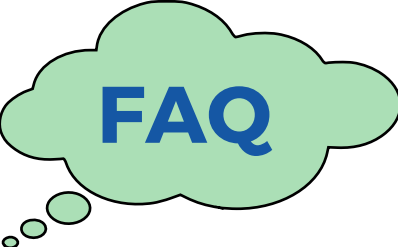
Who can join the Math Circle?

Math Circle is open to students from grades 6 to 8 who demonstrate a keen interest and aptitude in mathematics. Participation is determined through a selection test.

How can I apply for the selection test?

What does the selection test entail?

The selection test will assess mathematical reasoning, problem-solving skills, and conceptual understanding. It will entail 15 objective questions. There will be no need for calculators and there will be no negative marking

Is there a fee for the Math Circle?

The program is a self-funded, not-for-profit initiative. Participants are expected to contribute towards the nominal costs incurred for running the program. Organisers reserve discretion for waiver towards contribution towards the costs. Selected students with financial needs can apply for financial aid.

What is the duration of each session?

Each session lasts for approximately 2 hours.

Who conducts the sessions?

The problem discussion section will be conducted by experienced educators and mathematicians who are passionate about teaching and inspiring young minds.

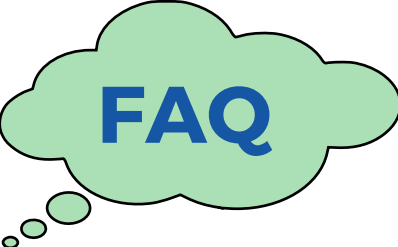
